

The Park Hotels and Apeejay Trust set up a drinking water plant in Hoysalanagar, Bengaluru

Project set up in association with Jaldhaara Foundation and WaterHealth India

<u>Hoysalanagar, Bengaluru, July 01, 2016:</u> Apeejay Surrendra Park Hotels and Apeejay Trust have partnered with Jaldhaara Foundation (JF) and WaterHealth India (WHN) to launch the first of its five (5) "WaterHealth Center" (WHCs) at Hoysalanagar ward number 80, Bengaluru urban, Karnataka. The water plant was inaugurated by **Manjunath Reddy, Mayor of Bengaluru**.

The "WaterHealth Center" provides access to safe and clean drinking water to over 50,000 people in Hoysalanagar of which over 35,000 people will be served in the immediate vicinity of the plant.

Speaking on the occasion, **Vijay Dewan, Managing Director, Apeejay Surrendra Park Hotels** said, "We at The Park Hotels recognize that clean drinking water is a basic need that has to be provided for every section of the society for healthy and clean living, unfortunately there are large sections of our society where this is still inaccessible. In our endeavor to find sustainable solutions for healthy living, we have found ideal partners in Jaldhaara Foundation and WaterHealth India who have a good track record of tackling this pressing issue in other parts of the country. I hope that this facility will help improve the quality of life of the families living in the immediate vicinity and will prove to be a model project for others to adopt in the city."

Jaldhaara Foundation's long term objective is to implement integrated WASH programs for underserved communities in India and other developing countries. The Foundation partners with reputed institutions/organizations to pursue such programs worldwide.

Speaking on the launch ceremony, **Arish Syed, Chief Executive Officer, Jaldhaara Foundation** said, "The current partnership with The Park Hotels and Apeejay Trust of the Apeejay Surrendra Group is another step towards achieving Jaldhaara's mission of implementing sustainable Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) solutions in over two thousand (2,000) communities by 2020."

The project builds on WaterHealth India's (technical partner for Jaldhaara Foundation) successful track record of managing over 500 community water systems called WaterHealth Centers (WHC) in India and Africa since 2006. The WaterHealth Center is the next generation water "micro-utility", with its six (6) stages purification process, delivering water quality that conforms to IS10500 and WHO standards.

The RO plants being set up in Bengaluru in Karnataka are state of the art water purifiers that will also recycle the reject water. The locations selected for setting up the plants have also been carefully chosen such that they serve the most underserved communities of Bengaluru urban wards.
